 - **Nursing:** Instead of “Patient showed signs of improvement,” say “Patient’s blood pressure and heart rate improved.”
5. **Combine Sentences When Appropriate:**
 - **Engineering:** “The material is strong. It is durable.” becomes “The material is strong and durable.”

- **Humanities:** “She was an excellent writer. She wrote many novels.” becomes “She was an excellent novelist.”
